Dear Ms. Hase:

This is a request for information under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140.

I request that a copy of the following documents, or documents containing the following information, be provided to me. I would like to obtain copies of these records.

1. Tree Preservation plan for Ackerman Park 2008 expansion, including tree species and condition, or any other document indicating the species, size and condition of the trees that will be removed.
2. Village Ordinance 5265
3. Finalized agreement between the Village and the owners of the property at the North West corner of St. Charles Rd. and Main St. regarding the annexation of that property and the agreement to transfer ownership of the stormwater detention facility to the Village at a later date
4. Any correspondence or record of public meetings with the residents (incorporated or unincorporated) living in the area between St. Charles Rd., Emerson Ave., Main St. and Lenox Rd. regarding the overland flow of stormwater into the new North Regional Stormwater Facility.
5. Any easements related to drainage and the overland flow of stormwater on the properties in the area between St. Charles Rd., Emerson Ave., Main St. and Lenox Rd.
6. Most recent drawings from McGurr, Ltd. for the North Regional Stormwater Facility and soccer fields at Ackerman Park.
7. Updated budget for the North Regional Stormwater Facility, including changes made by the Park District for ADA accommodations and drainage improvements
8. Calculations for the volume of stormwater overland flow to the North Regional Stormwater Facility for 20-year and 100-year storm events
9. Any engineering studies, topographic maps and/or grading plans related to the path of the overland flow of stormwater from the 5-Corners area to Ackerman Park.
10. Spending to date for planning, legal fees and engineering and any other costs related to the North Regional Stormwater Facility.
11. Funding sources for construction of the North Regional Stormwater Facility, including Village funding sources, bonds, county and/or state funds (before the sale of the Walgreens stormwater detention basin)

I understand that the Act permits a public body to charge a reasonable copying fee not to exceed the actual cost of reproduction and not including the costs of any search or review of the records. 5ILCS 140/6. I am willing to pay fees for this request up to a maximum of \$30. If you estimate that the fees will exceed this limit, please inform me first.

I look forward to hearing from you in writing within seven working days, as required by the Act 5 ILCS 140(3). Feel free to contact me by e-mail or through my home address.
